JOB SEARCH: Urban League continued to offer bi-weekly job search workshops on interviewing skills, resume writing, soft skills and placement during 2009 for 1,287 individuals. Workshops were provided for 448 people, 539 clients received job referrals and 133 clients were successfully placed in jobs. Pre-employment services were also provided for 115 older youth, where 25 participants received credentials and 29 entered post secondary education.

EDUCATION & YOUTH SERVICES: The Urban League's two computer labs continue to be popular with both children and adults. In 2009, a total of 377 persons, 202 youth and 175 adults attended computerized training at the Urban League.

Structured, educational activities were provided throughout 2009 for 518 youth, with an average daily attendance of 51. 123 youth who were not performing at grade level received assistance by certified teachers through the Standards-Based Academic Assistance (SAA).
